Life Application Questions:

1. In verses 14–16, how did the Philippians demonstrate their partnership with Paul? What words or phrases show the depth of their commitment?

2. Paul uses sacrificial worship language in verse 18 (“fragrant offering,” “acceptable sacrifice”). How does Paul’s view of generosity differ from how the world often views money, charity, or giving?

3. If God supplies “according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus,” how should that shape our confidence in both giving and receiving?

4. In what ways can we practice “sharing in the troubles” of others in our church family today? What might that look like in real, practical terms?
