Life Application Questions:

1. What does the scene in verses 14–18 reveal about human helplessness? Why were the disciples unable to solve the problem? What does the father's desperation teach us about our need for Christ?

2. What do you learn about faith from the father's statement, "*I believe; help my unbelief*"? How can genuine faith exist alongside doubts or struggles? Why is our confidence ultimately in Christ rather than in the strength of our faith?

3. What does Jesus' authority over the demon teach us about His power? Why do you think Jesus connected the disciples' failure with prayer? What does prayer reveal about our dependence upon God? What are some ways Christians can become self-reliant in their walk with Christ?
